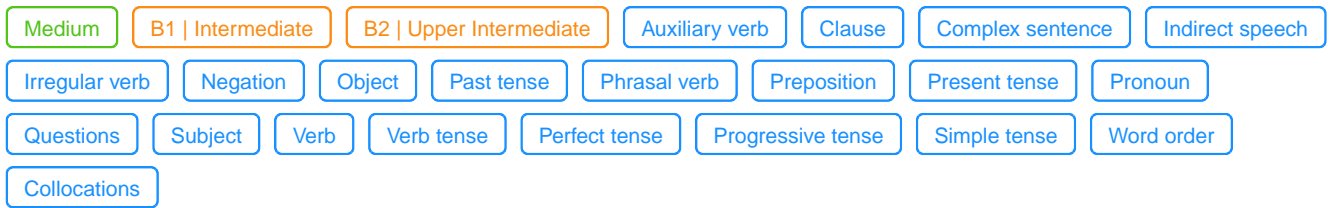


Forming Questions: Indirect, Tag, and Subject Forms
